

## Te Whakamutuka (conclusion)

The conclusion finishes with a song(waiata). The mana of the speaker is always enhanced if his speech is backed by a suitable song or chant. Women and men may accompany a speaker in singing a waiata.

A speaker may, after the waiata, finally summarise the greetings to all. The following speech ties those present to our ancestors and those who have passed on – binding us to the present.

No reira Ka piti hono, tātai hono Te huka mate ki te huka mate

Ka piti hono, tātai hono Te huka ora ki te huka ora Tēnā rā koutou katoa
